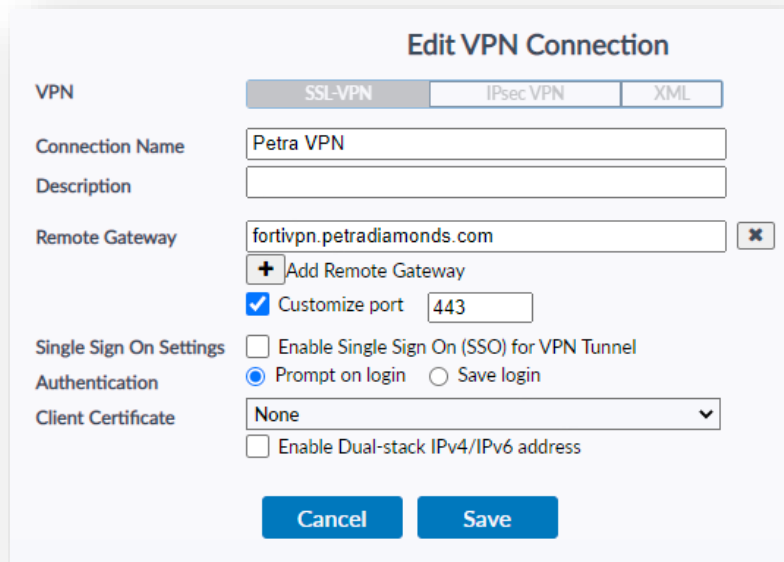


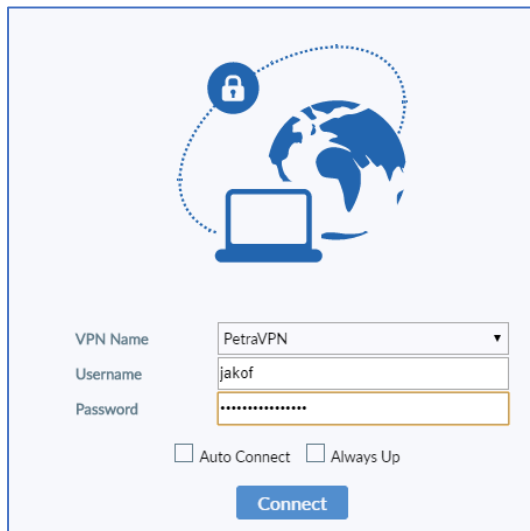
How to install and configure Petra VPN v3 (FortiClient)

1. Download and install FortiClient from the link below:
https://support.petradiamonds.com/VPN_Client/FortiClientVPN.msi
2. Configure a new connection within FortiClient as per below:
